

Planning the future

HELENSBURGH business leaders met last week with the man charged with revitalising the town.

The Burgh's Retailers' Association together with members of the Chamber of Commerce heard Derek Anderson, Chairman of the Helensburgh Partnership, outline developments in the plan to secure the future of the town's main shopping thoroughfares.

Mr Anderson is behind plans to revitalise the town centre and is also targeting problems such

as parking issues.

He told members that the partnership is working on issues including commissioning detailed reports of traffic arrangements in the town.

Compton McGill, Chair of Helensburgh Retailers, told the Advertiser: "Derek Anderson outlined what he's doing just now in terms of the reports he's commissioned. It's very early days for the Partnership and we felt it was very good of Derek to come along and keep us up to speed."
